Q: 70 – Title: Can a mother and her daughter go for Umrah without the company of the father?
Question
Is it possible for me and my daughter to go for Umrah without the company of my husband?
Answer
In the Name of Allah, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful.
As-salamu 'alaykum wa-rahmatullahi wa-barakatuh.
Firstly, it is prohibited in Shari'ah for a woman to travel the distance of safar (which is 48 miles or 78 km) without a mehram.
Rasulullah (Sallallahu Alayhi Wasallam) said: .« 0000 00 0000 0000 00000 00000 0000 0
.« 0000 00 0000 0000 0000 0000 00000 00000

This also includes the cases of a woman who wants to perform Hajj and Umrah. In the case of performing Hajj, if a woman has the financial means to do so, it will be compulsory upon her. However, according to the Hanafi Madhab she will also require a mehram to accompany her. If

"It is prohibited for a woman who believes in Allah and the Last Day to travel a distance of three

nights unless with a mehram" (Sahih Muslim #3324)

with a mehram. So in the case of Umrah, it will of course also be necessary for a mehram to
accompany her, otherwise it will not be permissible to undertake this journey.

she does not have a mehram, then this is a valid excuse to delay the Hajj until she is able to go
